Through discussion with families, staff and children, our aim is to remove the pressure and stress involved in home learning, with families able to participate as much or as little as they wish.

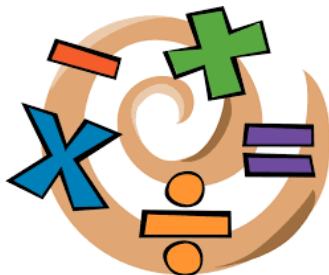
Maths and Numeracy

Literacy



When surveyed in 2020 and 2021, parents, staff and children all agreed that reading for enjoyment was of most value.

All children will have opportunities in school to choose books suited to their level to be enjoyed at home and in class.

P1-3 will be sent home fixed reading pages to be completed at home. This will help to consolidate the reading which has taken place in class.

Groups or individual children from P4-P7 may also be given set reading based on the level of support required. This will help to consolidate the reading which has taken place in class.

Teachers will make opportunities for children to share their reading for enjoyment in class.

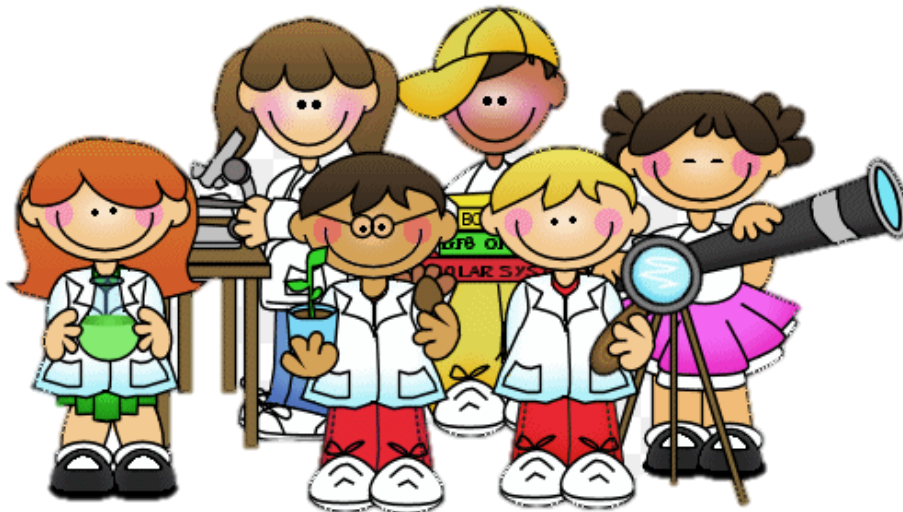
Reading for enjoyment will be displayed in some capacity in every classroom, with the purpose of sharing the value of an embedded reading culture.

Other Areas for Home Learning

Class teachers will share learning with home each week on our school app, either directly or through Twitter. This will allow parents to discuss learning in class and take this forward as families are interested.

Wider achievement will be shared in assembly each week so that children are able to share their learning from home.
